MATERIALS	WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED	RECYCLING PREPARATION	WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED
GLASS	All clear, green and brown glass containers, bottles, and jars.	RINSE. Labels can stay on. Remove plastic lids.	Fluorescent bulbs Light bulbs White glass Window glass Crystal Ceramics Cups/Dishes
METAL STEEL CANS	All cans including ends and lids.	RINSE cans, cut both ends out to conserve space and flatten. Labels may be left on. We encourage saving Campbell product labels for school.	Aerosol spray cans Batteries Paint cans No other Aluminum or steel at this time
ALUMINUM CANS			
PLASTIC CONTAINERS	Any size or color soda bottle Milk, water, liquid soap butter/whipped cream tubs and other colored number 1 through 7 plastic.	Labels can stay on. Remove metal rings and plastic caps. RINSE bottles. Look for recycling number 1 or 7 on the bottom of the bottle.	Pesticide containers & Herbicide containers Call: 381-1301 to recycle these items. Plastic Bags Antifreeze containers Oil Containers Plastic wrap
NEWSPAPER	Newspapers, including glossy sections.	KEEP PAPER CLEAN AND DRY.	Books Waxed or plastic coated paper. Paper foil (cigarette packs and some gum wrappers etc.) Cellophane (crisp, thin, transparent papers)
BROWN PAPER BAGS			
MAGAZINE	Any magazine & lightweight cardboard, cereal boxes, cracker boxes, etc. Cardboard packaging - corrugated.	KEEP PAPER CLEAN AND DRY.	
CARDBOARD			
PHONE BOOKS	Any phone book.	Deposit in containers at this drop off center.	
OFFICE PAPER & JUNK MAIL	All office paper and junk mail.	Deposit in containers at this drop off center.
